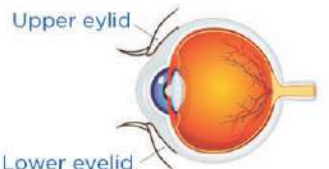
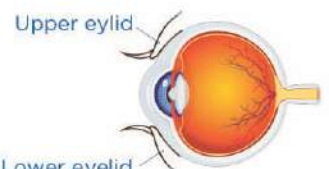
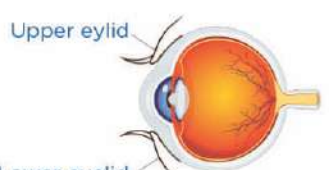

KERATITIS	 Cornea¹	 Red, watering eyes¹	Eye drops (antibiotic, antiviral or antifungal) ¹
SHINGLES	 Cornea²	 Sores on the cornea²	Consult an ophthalmologist ²
OCULAR HERPES	 Cornea²	 Redness, swelling and sores³	Can be managed with antiviral medication ²
BLEPHARITIS	 Upper eyelid Lower eyelid Eyelids⁴	 Red, swollen eyes with crusted lashes⁴	Prescribed topical ointment, eye drops and/or antibiotic medication ⁴
STYE	 Upper eyelid Lower eyelid Eyelids⁵	 A tender red bump at the base of the lashes or under the eyelid⁵	Topical antibiotics ⁶
CHALAZION	 Upper eyelid Lower eyelid Eyelids⁵	 A swollen bump on the eyelid⁵	Warm compresses, eyelid hygiene ⁶
UVEITIS	 Sclera Iris Ciliary body and muscle Choroid Uvea⁷	 Red, inflamed and sensitive eyes⁷	Treatment depends on the type and severity ⁸
CONJUNCTIVITIS	 Conjunctiva⁹	 Red, watery eyes with pus or discharge⁹	Treatment depends on the type and severity ⁹
